



ORDINANCE 11-09

ORDINANCE REGULATING DANGEROUS, INJURIOUS, UNHEALTHY MATTER ON STREETS OR SIDEWALKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF
TROUTMAN:

(1) It shall be unlawful to spill, pour, place, deposit, or allow to drip, fall or run upon the pavement or sidewalk of any street, alley or other public place in the Town of Troutman any brine, chemical, oil, grease, liquid or substance which tends to disintegrate the pavement or make it slippery or otherwise dangerous for pedestrians, horses or vehicles.

(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, cast, place or deposit on any sidewalk or crossing, in any street or public place in the town, any portion or part of any fruit, vegetable or other substance which, when stepped upon by any person, is liable to cause such person to slip or fall.

(3) No person shall throw or deposit upon any highway or street within the town any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans or any other substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle.

(4) Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown, upon any highway or street any destructive or injurious material shall immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.

(5) Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a highway or street shall remove any glass or other injurious substance dropped upon the highway or street from such vehicle.

(6) It shall be unlawful to throw, spill, place or deposit in or upon any street, highway, alley, sidewalk, park or other public place any dirt, filth, shells, garbage, vegetables, dead carcasses, sewage, slops, excrement, compost, stable manure, ashes, soot, tin cans, rags, waste paper, leaves, brush, weeds, grass, hay, excelsior, shavings, barrels, crates, boxes, litter, or loose combustible material, materials subject to be carried by the wind, or unwholesome, noxious to the smell, or putrescible matter of any kind.

(7) Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable under N. C. General Statute §14-4.

The above Ordinance was adopted at the regular meeting of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Troutman on the 14th day of May, 2009, a quorum being present.
